Randy Paul Hesson was born to Norman Jerome and Ellen Mae (Conkel) Hesson on May 27, 1954, at McCook, Nebraska and passed away on May 29, 2016 at York, Nebraska at the age of 62 years and 2 days. He was one of four children in the family.

Randy lived in McCook until the age of five when the family moved to O'Neil. During the next 10 years, due to his father's job with International Harvester, the family moved to numerous towns in Nebraska and Iowa. In 1970 the family moved to Uehling and in 1972 Randy graduated from Logan View High School. Randy attended the University of Nebraska in Lincoln where he was

an active member of the Beta Sigma Psi Fraternity and graduated in 1979. After graduating from college, Randy moved to York and began working for First Federal Savings and Loan.

On Jun 10, 1989, he was united in marriage to Vicki (Robare) Shaner of Geneva and they made their home in York for the next 27 years. In 1990, Cornerstone Bank purchased First Federal and for 12 years Randy served as Vice President of the Operations Department for Cornerstone Bank. In 1997, Randy graduated from the Graduate School of Banking in Madison, Wisconsin. Then in 2002 he became Vice President and Education Director to manage the newly formed Training Department. A position he held until his death.

Randy served as a member or officer in numerous clubs including: Jaycees, Sertoma and the Red Cross. He was also a charter member of the York Kiwanis Club.

He was preceded in death by his grandparents; father, Norman Hesson; father/mother-in-law, Marie and Kenneth Robare; brother, Craig Hesson and brother-in-law, Jerry Henderson.
