Robb Allen Davis was born to Lyle and Jane Davis in Omaha, Nebraska on February 7, 1953. He passed away on July 30, 2024, at his home in Geneva, Nebraska at the age of 71. He was one of 5 rowdy brothers. He spent his childhood years in Omaha and attained his GED. He married Candace Hansen on September 8, 1973, and had 3 daughters. He went to St. Paul Bible College in Minnesota and graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Bible and Theology. He moved back to Omaha and was divorced in 1981. Candy and Robb continued to be close and had a friendship until his death.

He moved to Geneva in the late 1990's and got a job at Geneva Welding and worked there for 30 plus years as a machinist until his retirement. He helped many farmers in Fillmore County to keep their machinery working. He never knew the word quit or that anything was unfixable. He loved the challenge. He could fix anything and was always proud when he overcame the impossible. I know that anyone who came into the shop knew that if Robb was on the case, it would get done right.

He was a very passionate reader and he read everything he could get his hands on. He always loved learning something new or expanding his knowledge on something he knew little about. Upon his death he was reading the Greek Bible in Greek, it was amazing.

He also loved his family with a passion. They were so important to him even to the very last day. Robb was a little rough around the edges and sometimes a little hard to get to know but, once you got through, he was the best person you could know. He was always willing to help with anything without expecting anything in return. He made everyone feel like they were cared for.

Robb loved his country as well; he believed in the Constitution and was not scared to tell someone his opinion about it. He believed that we could make this country great again and lived it every day.

Finally, he loved the Lord. He knew that he would be home someday and wasn't scared. He always said it would be the best day. He is home with the Heavenly Father and I know he is happy and at peace.

Robb was preceded in death by his parents, Lyle and Beverly (Woodbury) Davis.

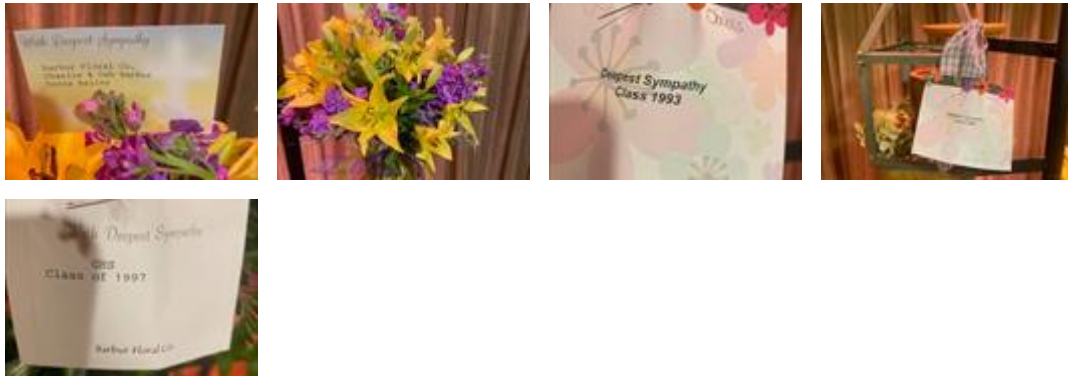
