Roger E. Coon was born April 28th, 1951 to Paul & Ardella (Casper) Coon in Beatrice, Nebraska. He passed away on April 27th, 2022 at Bryan West Hospital in Lincoln, Nebraska.

Roger grew up in Beatrice and graduated in 1969, then attended Kearney State College and graduated in 1973. Roger married Sandra Dvorak on May 31, 1971, and after he graduated from college they settled in Geneva where he began his teaching career.

Roger taught math and coached football and track. He very much enjoyed being around the students every day and each person was very special to him. Roger retired from teaching in 2006 but like most, he was restless and missed the environment at the school. He returned to the school as the evening janitor just 6 months later. Then after another short retirement from his janitor position, he again returned to the school he loved as a Para for the High School until his death.

Roger was an active member of the Prince of Peace Lutheran Church in Geneva. He enjoyed sports, mainly Fillmore Central Football, but especially supporting and watching his daughter and son in all the sports they participated in. As of late, he rarely missed a game any of his grandsons participated in or any other of their school activities. Roger enjoyed running, crossword puzzles, playing cards with his grandsons, wife, and mother-in-law, and mowing the lawn, "in straight lines".

Roger was preceded in death by his brother Larry; brother Kent; parents Paul and Ardella; father-in-law Fred Dvorak.

He is survived by his wife Sandi of Geneva; daughter Tara of Grand Island; son Dirk & wife Kylie of Fremont; grandsons Dawson, Dakota, Kolby, Creighton, Jarrett, Kyler, and Cooper all of Fremont; mother-in-law Evelyn Dvorak of Wilber; sister-In-Law Bonnie Charlesworth of Lincoln; sister Sandra & husband Art Warren of Chugwater Wyoming.

A Funeral Service for Roger was held on Saturday, April 30, 2022 at 10:30 a.m. at Prince Of Peace Lutheran Church in Geneva, Nebraska. Rev. Tim Stacy presided over the Funeral Service. Shaunna O'Brien was the organist and she accompanied the congregation in the singing of "The Old Rugged Cross," "How Great Thou Art," and "Just As I Am."

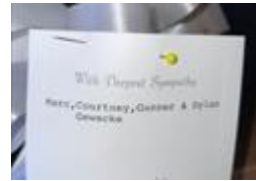

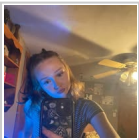
