Funeral services for Ronald will be held on Monday, April 14, 2014 at 11:00 a.m. at the United Methodist Church in Geneva. Pastor Ron Harris will be officiating the services. (Heath) Anderson on November 14, 1967 at Geneva, NE. Ronald died at his home in Lincoln, NE on April 9, 2014. He was one of three children in the family. Ronald was baptized May 12, 1968 and confirmed as a member of the Geneva United Methodist Church on April 12, 1981. Ronald grew up on the family farm and graduated from the Geneva High School with the Class of 1986. He was a member of FFA during those years serving as Treasurer his Senior year. Ronald attended the University of Nebraska at Lincoln majoring in advertising. He received his Bachelors Degree in 1990. Ronald began his working career in Hastings, NE at the Hastings Tribune. From there he returned to Lincoln where he worked for Alpha Graphics and the State Patrol. The past ten + years Ronald worked for Rembolt & Ludtke Law Firm in Lincoln as a legal executive assistant. Husker Baseball, the Pittsburgh Pirates and the Pittsburgh Steelers were great passions of Ronald's life. He attended the last game in the old Pirate stadium and the first game in the new one. Ronald held season tickets to Haymarket Park from the first game played on that field to the present time. He also followed Husker Baseball to five out of seven Dairy Queen Classics in Minnesota. Ronald and brother Rodney enjoyed many College World Series games together in Omaha. He was a dedicated and loyal fan all the way! Ronald made many special friendships through his love for baseball...always taking time to speak to everyone before the games began. His passion and presence will be greatly missed. Ronald was preceded in death by his mother Roine Anderson, brother Rodney Anderson, grandparents Melvin and DeVee Anderson, Arthur Heath, Grandmother and Step-Grandfather Merl and Irene Archer and Uncle Ron Heath.
