Sally Elaine (Betka) Coppedge, 73, passed away unexpectedly on December 17, 2022 following complications from a surgery.

Sally was born to Robert and Irene (Wiedow) Betka on August 24, 1949, in Geneva, Nebraska, where she grew up on the farm with her 3 older sisters and younger brother, who she was particularly close to. Sally and Bob spent

early days in the outdoors. She was a tomboy and even got a gun for Christmas when she was about 12 years old. Sally attended Country School #3. Sally was baptized and a member of the Geneva United Methodist Church growing up. She graduated from Geneva High School in 1967. Upon graduation Sally attended the Grand Island Business School for one year. At the age of 19, Sally moved to Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

Sally worked at the Daily Oklahoman for a while, met the love of her life, Troy Coppedge, and married him in the early 70's. Later, she found employment at the State of Oklahoma Revenue Department.

Sally's passion in life was rescuing Boston Terriers and placing (most of them) with suitable owners. Through her networking Sally made many lifelong friends. She could be tough but she had a soft spot and compassion for the underdogs and she had a passion for all animals. She enjoyed playing on a pool league in her younger years.

In the last couple of years Sally connected with a second cousin, Cindy (Tesar) Crawford, and her husband, Frankie, and their family. They gave her so much joy and happiness and a feeling of belonging to family, which she missed so much.

Sally was preceded in death by her parents, Bob and Irene Betka, brother-in-law, Kent Hall; Troy Coppedge; special friend, Don Yelton and his son, Chris Yelton.
