Even though she could no longer donate blood she never missed an American Red Cross Blood mobile in Fairmont. She volunteered for several years as an escort. She served on the Geneva Township Election Board, was a member of the Geneva Community Grange, the Fairmont Community Church and West Blue Aid Society. She was a GFWC Fairmont Women's Club member for 27 years and was the "Member of the Month" in September 2011. Sharon is preceded in death by her parents, her husband Ronald, son John, brothers Huebert and John Tutty, brother-in-laws Don Moul and Guy Brown, sister-in-law Ione Krejci and nephew Brian Moul.
