Stanley Eugene Allgood was born on November 7, 1950 to Charlie and Dorothy (Lovegrove) Allgood in Geneva, Nebraska. He was the oldest of 4 children. Stan passed away on February 11, 2021 in Falls City, Nebraska at the age of 70 years, 3 months, and 4 days.

Stan was baptized and confirmed at the Fairmont Methodist Church.

Stan grew up on a farm north of Geneva. He went to school at Geneva Public School, graduating with the class of 1969. He furthered his education at Milford Tech in diesel mechanics. After graduating, he went to work for Duteau in Lincoln before returning to Fairmont working for Ashby Farms. He later started driving truck for Co-Op and finished his truck driving career at Wynne Transport.

As an active member of the community, he had been an active member of the Fairmont Volunteer Fire Department, the Masonic Lodge, and the Shrine.

Stan was a fun-loving guy, that never knew a stranger. He appeared to be a bruiser on the outside, but was a big teddy bear on the inside.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Charlie and Dorothy Allgood.

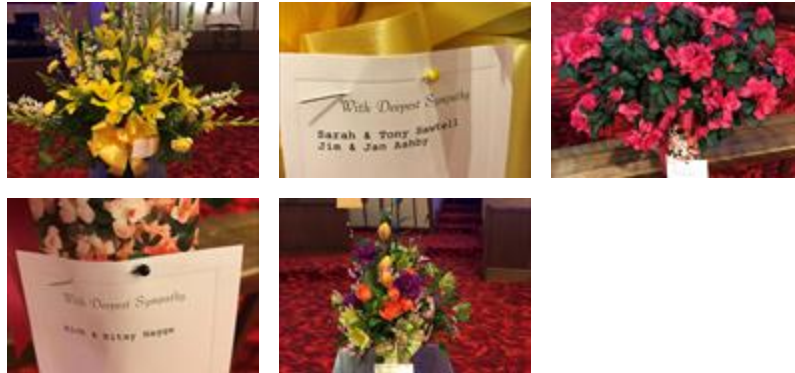
