Stanley Michael Dowdy, son of Max and Marj Dowdy, passed away peacefully on the night of July 5, 2023 at the age of 66. He was born September 28, 1956 in Hebron, Nebraska.

Stan was a brother to Doug and a beloved father of two sons: Luke and Brock. He was raised in Shickley, Nebraska on the family farm and graduated from Shickley High School. There he starred as a member of the 1974 State Championship football team and 1975 State Championship basketball team, where he was a starter at Quarterback and Point Guard. He then continued his studies at the University of Nebraska where he graduated with a BS in Agricultural Economics.
