



Steve J. Sadd

December 10, 1948 - June 6, 2024

Steven Joe Sadd was born to Albert Moses Sadd Sr. and Helen Kathrine (Abraham) Sadd on December 10, 1948 at Hastings, Nebraska. He died at his home in Lincoln, Nebraska on June 6, 2024 at the age of 75 years, 5 months, and 27 days. Steve was one of 8 children born in the family.

Steve grew up in the Glenvil area and graduated from Glenvil Highschool. He was married to Barbara Tjarks on May 29, 1965 and two children were born to this union: Kimberly JoAnn & Kirk Allen.

The family made their home in Glenvil, and Steve worked at Leverage Tools for 9 years while also working alongside his dad running Farmers Co-Op Oil. Steve also served on the church council at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Glenvil.

In 1981, the family moved to Geneva, Nebraska where Steve worked for Nelson Petroleum, John Workentine, Geneva High School (10 years), Heritage Crossings Nursing Home (16 years), and Fillmore County Fairgrounds (5 years). While living in Geneva, Steve also served on the Geneva City Council for 16 years.

After retirement, Steve and Barb moved to Lincoln on July 1, 2023.

Steve enjoyed camping, wood working projects, and performing small jobs for others. He was particular about his work and took great pride in anything he did. Steve & Barb also were proud of the grandchildren and enjoyed following their activities and events, never missing a speech meet, one act performance, football game, basketball game or or volleyball game.

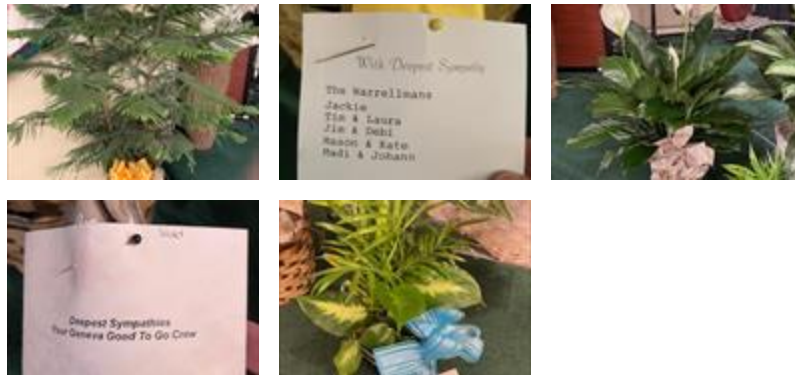
