Verne Gerald Moor of Portland, Oregon, formerly of Exeter, was born on January 13, 1935, and passed away in Portland on April 15, 2021. Verne was the son of Claude and Ida Mae (Hunt) Moor.

Verne was a proud member of the Exeter High School class of 1952. He lettered in football and was editor of the school newspaper. Growing up in a small town was a source of pride for Verne. No matter where he traveled, Exeter was always home.

Verne loved to tell stories about going to the Fairmont Air Base with his Dad when he was growing up. Those adventures, along with looking up to his brother Duane, encouraged him to join the US Army in January of 1955. Verne was part of the U.S. Infantry 187th Regiment, 10th Mountain Division. He returned from overseas in December of 1957 and stayed in the Inactive Reserves until December 31, 1962. While serving, he earned the level of marksman with the M1 and BAR rifles.

Verne was a man of intelligence and wit. Walking to the public library in Portland was his favorite pastime.

Verne was preceded in death by his parents; brother Duane (Tess) Moor; sisters Virginia (Les) Oates, Dr. Doris Julian, Lois (Ray) Dockter; and brother-in-law Bob Morris.
