Vivian was a life-long resident of Geneva. She graduated from Geneva High School with the Class of 1947. She was married to Gilbert Volkmer of Shickley, Nebraska on April 17, 1948 and to them 2 sons were born: Gary & Mark.

After her boys were in school, Vivian began working for Dr. Ray Cronk in his dental office and remained his faithful dental assistant for many years until retirement.
