A Celebration of Life

Warren Alfred Voss

Born ~ October 28, 1915

Entered into Eternity ~ June 6, 2015

Warren Alfred Voss entered this life in Becker, Minnesota on October 28, 1915, the second child born to Ihne Johnsen and Anna Aden-Voss.

He was baptized a child of God on December 5, 1915 at the home of his parents by Reinh Schierenbek in Becker, MN and, was confirmed in 1932 by Pastor Trost. He was a member of Zion Lutheran Church at Carleton and served as past President of the Lutheran Brotherhood.

In 1927 his family moved from Rockford, IA to Carleton, NE by train. His

Elementary School years were spent in Rockford, IA and District #90 located two miles northwest of Carleton. He attended High School at Carleton Public School.

Following High School he was employed by Standard Oil Company of Geneva and Henry C. Tagler at the Carleton Sale Barn.

On December 19, 1942 he was united in marriage to Tresa Marie Lietsch-Voss at Christ Lutheran Church in Davenport, Nebraska. This union was blessed with the birth of three children ~ Margaret Ann, Billy Carroll and Gary James.

As a young man 26 years of age, Warren entered the United States Army Air Force on May 23, 1943. Warren served his country in Saipan. He was honorably discharged on November 27, 1945 at Leavenworth, KS attaining the rank of Sargent in the 20th Air Force 73 Wing, 498 Bomb Group, 875 Bomb Squad.

Returning from the War, Warren was employed by the Union Pacific Railroad.

He was a member of the Remmer Henry Voss Post of the American Legion, serving as Commander of that post for 24 years.

Proud of the Community he lived in, he was honored to serve two years as Chairman of Milo Day. He served eight years on the Village of Carleton Town Board and participated in various other areas throughout the years.

On March 1, 1955, Warren opened the Warren A. Voss Skelly Service Station in Carleton, Nebraska retiring in 1983.

Warren & Tresa spent a portion of their "Golden Years" at Heritage Crossings

Assisted Living in Geneva, Nebraska where Warren spent hours putting puzzles together and playing UNO with his Assisted Living friends.

He recently resided at Fairview Manor in Fairmont, Nebraska where the staff and residents created the fondest of memories and fulfillment of many items on his "bucket list" such as a hot air balloon ride, airplane rides, Nebraska State Fair visit, and Exeter-Milligan's High School State Football Championship game played at Memorial Stadium.
