Wilma R. (Steider) Lichti was born to David and Elma (Springer) Steider on November 6, 1932, on a farm south of Shickley, Nebraska. She passed away on October 11, 2023, at College View Assisted Living in Hastings, Nebraska at the age of 90 years 11 months and 5 days. She was one of seven children in the family.

In her youth, the family moved to Shickley. Wilma was baptized in the Salem Mennonite Church where she remained a lifelong member. She graduated with the Shickley High School class of 1950. Wilma began working at Geneva State Bank following her graduation.

On October 10, 1953, Wilma was united in marriage to Richard D. Lichti and to this union three sons were born: Dennis, Michael and Jon. After marriage, Wilma started working at Shickley State Bank where she worked until 1956 when her first son was born. At that time, she decided to be at home spending time with her family.
